

## Component 1: Performance and choreography

- What's assessed
- 1. Solo performance in the style of? E.g Akram Khan, Christopher Bruce, Richard Alston
- 2. Performance in a quartet
- 3. Choreograph a group dance
- How it's assessed

Practical exam 80 marks 50% of AS level

 Externally set tasks are distributed by 15 September in the academic year of certification.

### Component 2: Critical engagement

#### What's assessed

One compulsory set work within the compulsory area of study (Rooster and Rambert Dance Company).

One optional set work within the compulsory area of study (Sutra and Independent Contemporary dance Scene).

#### How it's assessed

Written exam: 2 hours 30 mins 100 marks 50% of AS level

#### Questions

Two sections:

Section A: short answer questions (25 marks) and one essay (25 marks) on Rooster and Rambert.

Section B: two essay questions on set work/area of study (Sutra and ICDC)
