## The Prevent Duty at Kesgrave High School

As a school, we aim to keep our students safe from harm and this includes protecting them from the risk of radicalisation.

Provision is in place to:

- Ensure staff are able to identify students who may be vulnerable to radicalisation.
- Ensure staff know what to do if students have been identified.
- Protect students from the risk of radicalisation as part of our safeguarding duties, whether these risks come from within the family or are the product of outside influences.
- Build students resilience to radicalisation by promoting fundamental British values and enabling pupils to challenge extremist views. (We will be a safe space where students can understand the risks associated with terrorism and develop the knowledge and skills to be able to challenge extremist arguments).
- Within our curriculum, we will ensure that we assist our students in their personal, social and emotional development and understanding of the world.
